Renovations nearing completion at West Holt Medical Services

ATKINSON — West Holt Medical Services Foundation Board members and Michael Coyle, CEO of West Holt Medical Services (WHMS) is excited to announce that in 2011 the Foundation gave \$198,832 to the WHMS for assistance in completing renovations projects at the hospital, construction for the new therapy services building as well as providing additional equipment needs.

Before the renovations began at WHMS, the Foundation committed to WHMS \$350,000 to be paid over a five year period. Michael Coyle, CEO of WHMS says “The renovation costs will be adequately funded by private donor contributions and by USDA money. Just as pledges and support continue to roll into the Foundation office for these renovation projects and other development needs of WHMS, the first phase of renovations will be completed mid-January 2012. This phase included renovations of the nurses’ station, doctor’s dictation room, nurse’s report room, all patient rooms, and family room along with a fresh look to the hospital hallways. The renovations also provided an addition of the following new rooms: extended care patient room, a bariatric patient room, a minor procedure room and a medication dispensing room.”

Monique Johnson, Foundation Director says, “With the completion of these renovations, the Foundation will begin to heavily promote the Commemorative Naming Opportunities Tribute Program at the hospital and new therapy services building”.
