LARGE DONATIONS IMPROVE WEST HOLT MEDICAL SERVICES.

A large donation has been made by an anonymous donor to West Holt Memorial Hospital to purchase new TV's for the patient rooms. "All of the flat screen TVs have been installed and the patients are really enjoying them. It's fantastic that someone would donate something so great to this facility" said Terri Mitchell, CNO of West Holt Memorial Hospital.

The Foundation was able to donate \$50,000 for several purchases. West Holt Memorial Hospital will be installing a new patient call system for the patient rooms in the hospital. The call system is designed to alert the staff of patient's needs as they arise. Another purchase is two new portable Automated External Defibrillators (AED). The AED's have been placed in the two clinics, West Holt Medical Clinic and Bassett Family Practice, to shock the heart if a patient's heart stops. The last portion of the donation was used to purchase 11 new beds for West Holt Memorial Hospital and the old beds have been donated to Parkside Manor in Stuart. West Holt's new beds have mattresses that are self adjusting to help prevent soreness and discomfort, they are able to weigh the patients and will work with the new TV's to offer a comfortable stay. "With the increasingly high cost of equipment and technology, we truly appreciate all the donations we receive through the foundation to help continually improve West Holt Medical Services."
